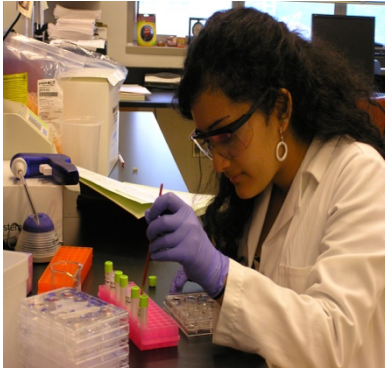

**June 5 - July 28, 2017**

*The Institute On Neuroscience (ION/Teach) is an eight-week, paid, summer research program for exceptional high school students and middle or high school science teachers.*

The program consists of an introductory neuroscience course and a seven-week mentored laboratory research placement for both Student and Teacher Scholars. Additional weekly professional development workshops focus on topics such as scientific communication, ethical conduct of research, college preparation (students), and translate research topics into standards-based lesson plans (teachers).

ION/Teach provides Student and Teacher Scholars the opportunity to conduct cutting-edge neuroscience research at Atlanta-area universities, prepare for the pursuit of undergraduate science majors (students), and the opportunity to network and interact with fellow teachers and faculty members (teachers).
